



Presenting The 2010 Tournament Club



Dear Woodlands Golf & Country Club Tournament Player:

The Woodlands Golf & Country Club is pleased to present the **2010 Tournament Schedule and 2010 Tournament Club Program**. The Tournament Club Program has been an overwhelming success and The Professional Staff and Members at the Woodlands have been coming up with ideas that will help continue to **Maximize Tournament Participation**. **The 2010 Tournament Club will once again prove to be a true win-win situation for the "Tournament Player," and the club itself**. We have a rather diverse Tournament Schedule planned for 2010. We have even added a few events to the schedule this year. The program will attempt to address the interests and demands of the majority of our members.

Attached, please find a Tournament Schedule for 2010. We have tried to avoid all conflicts, including SCGA events, USC and Clemson Football games, and USGA Qualifying Tournaments. The dates of the tournaments are subject to change, however, we do not anticipate more than one or two changes. The tournament formats vary from fun to competitive, and we will award gross and net prizes (if applicable) in most events.

This Year's Tournament Club Program will give Members of The Woodlands Two Options:

Option # 1 – The Everything Is Included Tournament Club Fee (New for 2010)

The Everything Is Included Tournament Club Fee for will be \$300 for Men and \$230.00 for Ladies. This fee can be billed over your February, March and April club Statements. If you select this option, your entry fee will be paid for all 24 Tournament Club Events. The only fee you will have to pay the day of the tournament is the applicable cart fee. This is a savings of over \$350.00. The only events not included in The Everything Is Included Tournament Club Fee will be the Member-Guest, Senior Club Championship, and The Parent-Child Tournament. All of the other 24 Tournament Club Events (**those shown in Blue on The 2010 Tournament Schedule**) are included.

Option # 2 – The 2010 Tournament Club - The annual membership fee for The 2010 Tournament Club Fee for Men will be \$225.00 and can be billed in three installments of \$75.00 over your February, March, and April club statements. The 2010 Tournament Club Fee for Ladies will be \$180.00 and can be billed in three installments of \$60.00 over your February, March, and April club statements. Additional Family Members (children only) may be added for \$120.00 each. **Your membership in the Tournament Club entitles you to participate in 13 Woodlands Golf & Country Club events at no charge other than the cart fee**. In conjunction with designated events, complimentary meals, along with some other goodies before and/or after the tournaments will be included in the Tournament Club Membership Fee. In addition, men will also receive a \$50.00 discount for the Member-Member Tournament, and all Tournament Club members will receive a \$10.00 discount for each of the Pick Your Pro Events, Flag Day Tournament, and a \$15.00 discount for the Sadie Hawkins and Couples Championship.

New for 2010, we have added a "Steak and Beans" Tournament (Ryder Cup Style Competition), a Clemson Carolina Challenge, and we have also added The Buster Tournament to The Tournament Schedule. Also, All Pick The Pro Qualifying Rounds MAY BE PLAYED on The Saturday or The Sunday of The Championship Weekend in 2010.

There will not be any MGA Dues Collected in 2010.

Anyone signing up for the Tournament Club will also receive 100 Ruby Cup Points (please read below)

Another bonus of being a member of the Tournament Club will be the opportunity and competition to become a member of one of the two "Ruby Cup" teams that will participate in The 5th Annual Ruby Cup Matches in October. The Professional Staff will be keeping track of "Money" and "Points" leaders throughout the year. You will receive participation points for each event in which you participate and you will also be able to earn competition points based on your finishes in the tournaments. This event has been a huge success over the last three years and will be a very special weekend of golf for all of those that make the 2010 teams.

The Tournament of Champions will return again in 2010. It will be played the Saturday before the Par 3 Tournament in December. Winners from designated Tournaments will earn the right to compete in this year-end finale.

It is easy to see that even if you happen to miss a couple of events along the way, it is still a great investment! If you are a serious "Tournament Player," and plan on playing in almost all of the events in 2010, we would encourage you

to consider the Everything Is Included Tournament Club in 2010. More importantly, being a member of the Tournament Club will give you the opportunity meet new friends and playing partners.

The LGA will also still host 4 events in 2010. The LGA Kick-Off Tournament, The LGA Member-Member Tournament, The LGA Member-Guest Tournament, and The Year-End, LGA Round-Up Tournament.

Lastly, we will hold 8 Woodlands Dogfights throughout 2010. There will be a \$15.00 entry fee for each Dogfight. We will serve lunch after each Dogfight. Dogfight pairings are done via the golf shop.

The staff at the Woodlands Golf & Country Club is extremely excited about the upcoming season/tournament schedule and hope you will choose to participate in this worthwhile program. With your help, we will continue to build on the tremendous success the club has experienced in the past. We sincerely welcome any input you may have regarding the Tournament Program and we look forward to a great year in 2010.

- **Once one family member joins the Tournament Club, your child/children may be added for \$120.00 each**
- A chance to participate on one of two “Ruby Cup Teams” in October – An estimated \$100.00 value
- A chance to participate in the “Steak and Beans” Competition
- A chance to participate in the Tournament of Champions
- A Wide Variety of exciting and fun-filled tournaments designed to meet the needs of all types of players.
- Competition from any set of tees (when designated) with the appropriate USGA handicap adjustment
- Complimentary Meals and Other Goodies before/after the designated tournaments.
- Sensational Awards Banquet for all Tournament Club Members at the end of the Season. (Nominal charge for Spouse/Date)
- Guaranteed perfect weather for all events.
- Players are responsible for signing themselves up for each tournament during the Designated Registration Period. The Deadline to sign up is usually the Thursday Before Each Event.
- In some events, preferred tee times and/or pairings cannot be accepted due to the size of the fields and the amount of work involved. Please do not make any special requests in the Match Play, Net Championship, Club Championship or Member-Member and Member-Guest.
- SPEED OF PLAY will be monitored on a regular basis and we ask each participant be aware/considerate of the groups around them.
- You must have an established Handicap (10 rounds or more) to be eligible to join the Tournament Club and participate in any Woodlands Golf & Country Club Event. If you do not have an established handicap index, please see a member of the Professional Staff

For your convenience, the 2010 Tournament Schedule is included with this letter. Be on the lookout and make your plans now to be in town for as many events as possible. *Please make a note of each tournament on your calendar today.* If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact Tom Mason at 788-6658. Final Note: You do not have to be a Member of the Tournament Club to play in Woodlands Golf & Country Club Events. However, if you do elect to play in a Tournament Club Event, you will have to pay the all entry fees for the specific tournament.
